
FOLD A PAPER SWAN

You will need:


A square piece of paper.

Top tip: Make sure that all creases are done well.


1. Fold your square in half, corner to corner, crease and open out again.




2. Fold two opposite corners into the centre fold line.



3. Fold these edges into the centre again.



4. Turn your paper over and fold the bottom point up to the top point.




5. Fold this in half along your centre line.


6. Rotate the paper ninety degrees anticlockwise so the long flat edge is at the bottom.




7. Slowly raise the inside triangle.



8. Flatten and crease.



9. Fold this back on itself to create the head and beak.



10. Fold up the flaps on each side of the body to create wings.



11. Your finished swan should now sit up.
