GAFFER TAPE FLOWER

A 'Make' by Caroline Coates

You will need:

A pencil, gaffer tape and scissors.



First make the petals:

1. For each petal, cut or tear a piece of tape about 6-7cm.



2. Fold over one corner most of the way across.



3. Then the other corner to make an arrow shape.



4. Make around 25 of these for your flower.

Then assemble the flower:

5. One at a time, wrap the petals around the top of your pencil.



6. Make sure the top of the pencil is hidden. Continue to wrap the other 24 pieces around the pencil.



7. Make sure the points are around the same height and equally spaced, in a circle.





Top Tips: Use green tape to cover the pencil and make more arrow shapes to create leaves and add more petals for a fuller flower.
